### Instructions

The display produced using this data is to be consistent with DoD Financial Management Regulation (FMR) 7000.14-R, specifically, the display in Volume 2A, Chapter 3. The PDR is more current and supersedes the FMR as it is updated annually. The FMR will be updated to ensure its consistency with the PDR.
- 2) Provide individual training throughput quantity (input, output and workload) by component, individual training category, and individual training type (see the list in definitions) for fiscal years (FYs) 2014 through 2016, where FY 2014 represents actuals and FYs 2015 appropriated or authorized, and 2016 projected throughput (quantity).
- 3) Quantities will be provided in actual numbers. DO NOT enter in thousands.
